Western Sustainability Pulse Survey: Prize Draw Rules

The Western Sustainability Pulse Survey is an annual means of gathering feedback and assessing knowledge in the Western community.

Participants are encouraged to answer honestly and complete the entire survey. At the end of the survey, participants are prompted to disclose their Western email address (username@uwo.ca), to be eligible for a chance to win a prize.

The survey and the opportunity to enter into the draw shall close at 11:59 pm on November 3, 2023. You may submit your survey without providing your email address. In order to be eligible for the draw however, you must be an employee or student of Western University and you must provide your correct Western email address either at the end of the survey or as described below.

For your participation and if you decide to provide your Western email address at the end of the survey, you will be entered into a **draw for one of three Western Bookstore gift cards (valued at \$100.00 each).** There are three prizes to be awarded. Odds of winning the prize are based on number of participants who provided their Western email address prior to the close of the survey.

Information collected to draw for the prize will not be linked to the survey data in any way, and this identifying information will be stored separately, used only to administer the draw, and then destroyed after the prize has been awarded. You may decline to respond to any survey question by leaving it blank with no loss of your chance to win the prize.

Once the survey closes, the compiled list of participant email addresses will be randomized (using Excel functions) to select three winners. Please note that you do not need to participate in the survey to be eligible for the draw. If you wish to be entered into the draw without participating in the survey, please email sustainability@uwo.ca by 11:59 pm on November 3, 2023 using your Western email address and indicating your desire to be entered into the draw and must promptly and accurately answer an arithmetic skill-testing question to be declared a winner of the prize.
